The 8:15 service goes on Summer break after this Sunday (June 3 - September 2nd) and returns on September 9th.

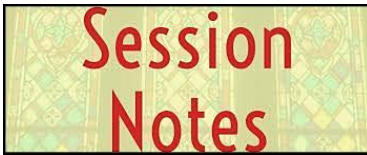

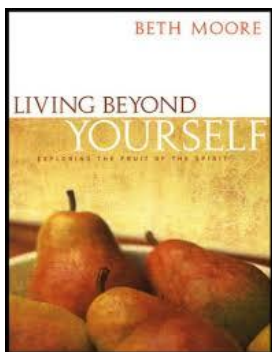
We need your help/donations for these hygiene kits. Here's what is needed:
